
ATTACH TALL UPRIGHT.

Attach the tall upright to the shelves as shown with the hardware provided.



Step 05

ATTACH HANDLES AND PLACE TRAY.

Attach handles by threading them together in the tube location as shown.

Place tray on shelf surface to complete assembly.



Additional Information

CLEAN

Clean metal surfaces with a slightly damp, soft cloth. To remove dirt and fingerprints, use a quality cleaner formulated for metal furniture. Wipe completely dry with a soft cloth.

MAINTAIN

Weathering and color variation over time is natural for teak outdoor furniture. For best results, we recommend the following care: Wipe spills with a clean dry cloth, cover furniture in the off-season, and store indoors during winter months.

PROTECT

To protect and revive weathered furniture, it is recommended to seal teak furniture. Water based sealants are most effective on bare wood, consult with your local hardware professional to select the sealant best suited for your outdoor furniture.
